

Coach Selection Criteria for the AIBA 2009 World Championships

• **Mandatory Eligibility Requirements Position**

- Be a Canadian citizen
- Have a valid driver's licence
- Be 25 years old of age or older
- Have a valid Canadian passport
- Have valid coaching certificate(s)
- Have valid first-aid and CPR training card
- Be a member of Boxing Canada in good standing
- Be a member of Coaches of Canada

• **Qualification Criteria For Head Coach**

- Criminal background check.
- Must currently hold at least NCCP Level 4 coaching certification.
- Proven coaching experience at high level international events in Boxing Canada programs within the last three years.
- Must demonstrated ability to develop and monitor training programs of high performances athletes.
- Commitment to the World Championships Team program
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to motivate and encourage team building
- Must have extensive experience in Boxing Canada training Camps.
- Must demonstrate an overall ability to understand the international style of boxing, and a willingness to adapt his/her coaching style to meet the demands of the athletes, and the challenges the athletes will face during the International Competition.
- Proven ability to establish harmonious relationships with athletes, and other team personnel.
- Proven ability to handle crisis management situations as well as routine administrative duties.
- Ability to accept responsibility for the enforcement of the Boxing Canada Code of Conduct leading up to and during International Competition.
- Sign and abide by the Canada Boxing Code of Conduct.
